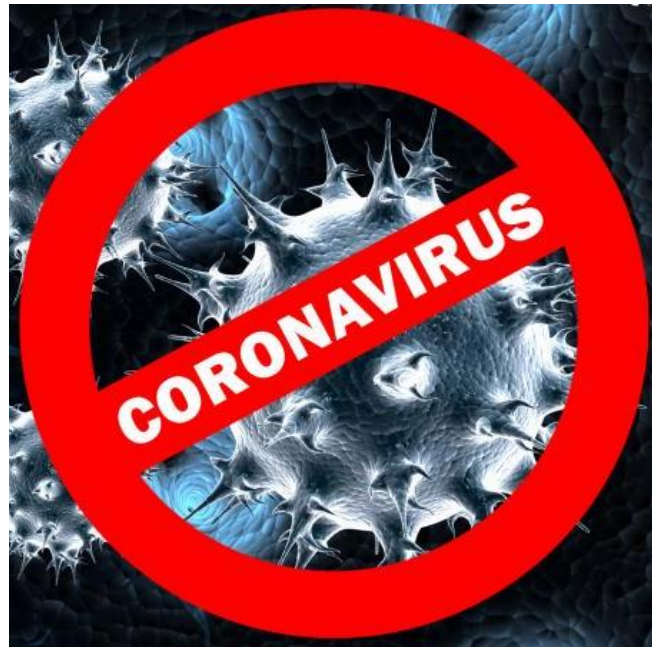


2021 Transition from COVID Lockdown

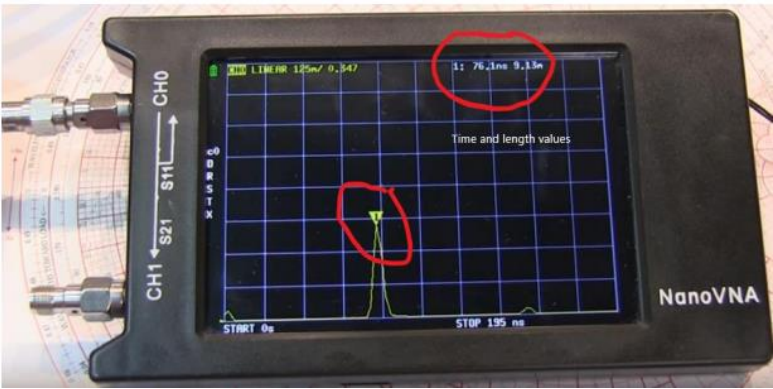

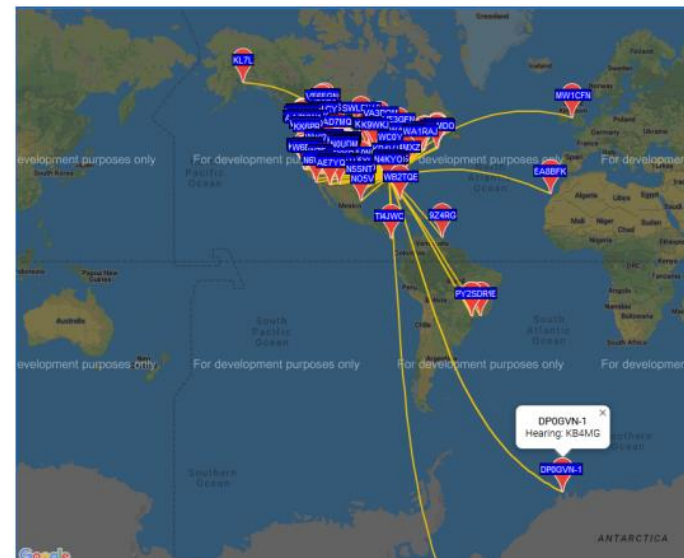

WB9GFA-Final Diagram

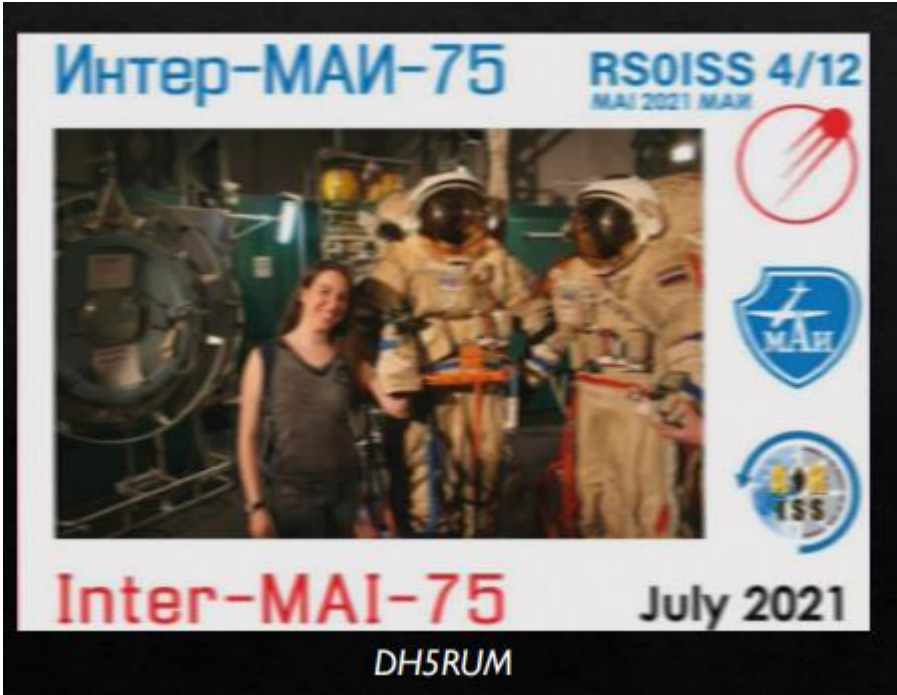
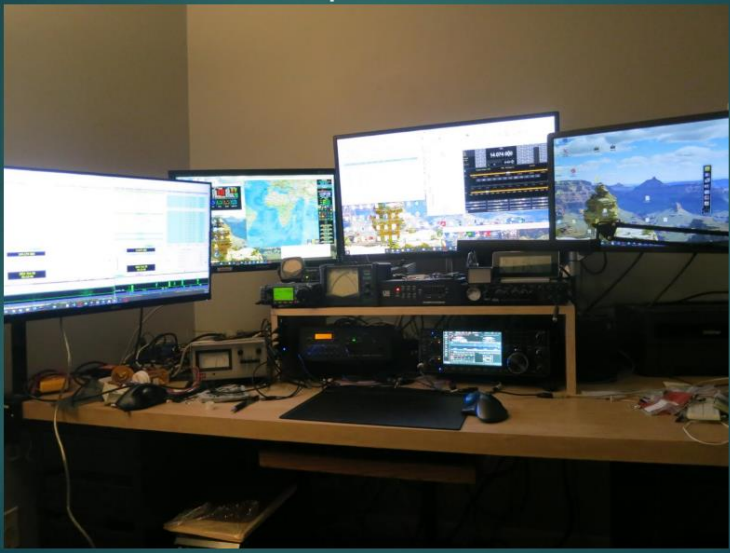
